Louis van Beethoven ist ein deutsch-österreichisch-tschechischer Fernsehfilm aus dem Jahr 2020 von Nikolaus Stein von Kamienski mit Tobias Moretti, Anselm Breggott und Colin Pütz als Ludwig van

Beethoven in unterschiedlichem Lebensalter, der im Auftrag von Degeto, WDR und ORF produziert wurde. Premiere des Historienfilms war am 27. Oktober 2020 bei den 42. Biberacher Filmfestspielen, wo die Produktion als Eröffnungsfilm gezeigt wurde. Im ORF wurde der Film im Rahmen eines Programmschwerpunkts zum 250. Geburtstag Beethovens am 23. Dezember 2020 erstmals gezeigt.

Der achtjährige Louis van Beethoven wächst in Bonn auf und gilt als musikalisches Wunderkind. Nachdem Versuche seines Vaters Jean, den jungen Louis zu unterrichten, scheitern, nehmen ihn Christian Gottlob Neefe sowie der Schauspieler und Sänger Tobias Pfeiffer unter ihre Fittiche. Beim jungen Beethoven wird ein freiheitsliebender Geist erweckt. Er will unabhängig sein und nur der Kunst dienen. In einem ersten kurzen Aufenthalt in Wien begegnet er 1787 Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart in einer Zeit politischer Umbrüche, die in der Französischen Revolution gipfeln. Ludwig muss einige familiäre Schicksalsschläge erdulden und kann die Liebe der jungen Adligen Eleonore von Breuning – Tochter seiner Ziehmutter Helene von Breuning – nicht erwidern. Im Winter 1792 zieht er nach Wien, um bei Joseph Haydn zu lernen. Die Jahre von 1792 bis 1826 werden im Film hingegen nicht behandelt, wenngleich auch Musik aus dieser Zeit als Begleitung der Handlung zu hören ist.

1779. Eight-year-old Ludwig van Beethoven, called "Louis", is already known as a musical prodigy. He learns to go his own way - much to the dismay of the people around him. Some years later, he meets Mozart during times of political upheaval. The unconventional genius and French Revolution are sparking a fire in Louis' heart; he doesn't want to serve a master - only the arts. Facing times of family tragedies and unrequited love, he almost gives up. However, Louis makes it to Vienna to study under Haydn in 1792, and the rest is history. Who was this man, whose music has since touched countless hearts and minds? At the end of his life, the master is isolated by loss of loved ones and hearing. Surely though, he was way ahead of his times.



With English subtitles, again perfect for those members who want to be there but are not yet quite so proficient in the German language. So come with friends and family.
